Zbornik radova Filozofskog fakulteta u Nišu, Serija Matematika is published yearly; it publishes original papers in all fields of pure and applied mathematics.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

All manuscripts (the original and a copy) must be written in English. The extent of the papers is limited to ten pages in length (preferably an even number of pages); manuscripts over 10 pages are accepted only exceptionally. Papers accepted for publication, will be reproduced by a photographic process from the original manuscript which must be typewritten on good quality heavy white paper using black carbon ribbon and ink for the symbols entered by hand. Manuscripts should not require many corrections; when mailed, the sheets should not be folded.

The typing area is 170 x 250 mm (about 66 letters x 39 lines in 1,5 line spacing). A space of 8 cm. deep (within the typing area) should be left open at the top of the first page; the author(s) should write their names, addresses and the title of the paper on a separate sheet. All manuscripts should start with a short Abstract in single line spacing separated from the following text by triple-spacing and include the footnote AMS Subject Classification (1980): on the first page. Definitions, theorems, lemmas, remarks proofs etc. (these words should be written in capitals using only one of two alternative styles: DEFINITION 2. 1. or 3. 2. THEOREM consistently throughout the paper) should be separated from the text by 2, 5 spacing. The heading of each section which starts at left margin, should be underlined; the main notions can be underlined, too.

Figures are included in the text and must be numbered (by arabic numbers) and mentioned in the text; they should be prepared in black ink, Equations (or formulas) must be numbered (for future references) in parentheses () at the left margin.

References (single line spacing within each reference, 1,5 line spacing between consecutive references; the word references should be written in capitals centered) should be listed alphabetically in the following form:
