Mathematica Moravica is published twice a year. It publishes original papers in all fields of pure and applied mathematics.

INSTRUCTION FOR AUTHORS

All manuscripts (original and copy) must be written in English. The extent of the papers must not exceed 16 pages; manuscripts over 16 pages are accepted only exceptionally. Manuscript should not require many language corrections.

MATHEMATICA MORAVICA is typesetted in L^AT_EX 2_ε. Authors are encouraged to prepare their manuscripts in L^AT_EX 2_ε using `amsart` document class, although other widely used document formats are accepted (MS Word, SWP L^AT_EX). Papers should be submitted for assessment in electronic format (PDF, T_EX, DOC) to the e-mail address: `mmoravica@gmail.com`. If the paper is accepted for publication, the author will be asked to send the paper in editable format (T_EX, DOC).

The author(s) should write their names, addresses, and the title of the paper on a separate sheet. All manuscripts should start with short Abstract and include 2000 Mathematics Subject Classification in the footnote of the first page.

Figures, if any, should be numbered and referenced in the text, but submitted as separate EPS files, or some other widely accepted format (cdr, vsd, ps...). Equations must be labeled by arabic numbers in parentheses at the left margin, if referenced in the text.

References should be listed alphabetically in the following form:
