The manuscripts should include:

- 1. Title, with a (shortened) running title.
- 2. Author's name: first name(s) or initials, surname.
- 3. Abstract, at most 20 lines long. In the case the paper is not in English, an English translation of the title and abstract should be supplied.
- 4. 2010 AMS Mathematics Subject Classification, as well as MathEduc Classification, and Key words.
- 5. Author's full postal address and e-mail address.

We would appreciate if an electronic version (.pdf or .doc) of the manuscript is included.

Each submitted manuscript will be reviewed by at least two anonymous referees. On acceptance of the paper, the authors will be asked to transmit the source .tex or .doc file by e-mail.
