## Author Guidelines

GENERAL- Authors are invited to submit three copies of their manuscripts, written in English, double spacing, to anyone of the editors at address of the journal. It is understood to imply that the article is original and unpublished elsewhere. In order to publish the paper as quickly as possible after acceptance, authors are encouraged to submit the final text by e-mail.

ABSTRACT around 100 words of length, should be given.

NAME(S) AND TITLES should be specified: initials or given name first, family name (in capitals) last, full mailing address(es). Titles, both of the article itself and of the sections, should be brief and specific. Sections should be decimally numbered at no more than two levels.

KEYWORDS should be typed in separate lines and numbered in parentheses on the right. Avoid double subscripts or superscripts.

TABLES AND FIGURES are numbered and should have titles and captions.

REFERENCES are indicated by Arabic numerals enclosed in square brackets. In the list of references they are listed alphabetically. List of references should contain items published in open literature: in journals, books, conference proceedings or as technical reports of official institutions. Journal names should be written out in full.
